- 1940 Graduated from high school and joined the US. Army serving in WWII under General Patton
- Played second base and trained as a pitcher while on the Army team
- 1948 Began Fast Pitch Softball career in Corpus Christi Leagues
- 1948-1952 Pitched a number of no-hitters and one-hitters
- 1952-1996 Played Fast Pitch in city leagues
- Participated in numerous T.A.A.F. State Tournaments as a player
- 1954 Began umpire career in Fort Worth
- Has been umpiring T.A.A.F. tournaments since the 1960's
- 1971 Became Umpire-In-Chief for Metro Fort Worth
- Since 1982 has attended all ASA Umpire-In-Chief clinics hosted in Oklahoma City
- Umpired for five (5) National ASA Tournaments and served as UIC or Assistant UIC in five (5) tournaments
- Has spent his umpiring career recruiting, training and evaluating umpires while striving to learn more effective ways
