- 1. Who can participate? Answer- the TAAF Games of Giving are open to anyone and everyone. From Athletes, Coaches, Mom, Dad, Friends, Family and your next door neighbor.
- 2. How much does it cost? Answer- \$0 It's FREE, no entry fee, NO registration fee! 100% of the proceeds benefit fellow Texans.
- 3. How does it work? Answer Do one of 4 things and WIN A MEDAL! 1. Drop off 10 nonperishable goods (sample list available on <a href="www.taaf.com/gamesofgiving">www.taaf.com/gamesofgiving</a>) at a designated drop off location (list available on <a href="www.taaf.com/gamesofgiving">www.taaf.com/gamesofgiving</a>) 2. Donate \$5 to Feeding Texas (click <a href="HERE">HERE</a> to donate) 3. Donate Blood at a local Blood Bank (<a href="list of Blood Banks">list of Blood Banks</a>) 4. Do a "good deed" example- Doing a favor for a neighbor or friend, cleaning up a public place, being a pen pal to an elderly person or volunteering at a food bank or church. The list is endless! Just do something nice and tell us about it!
- 4. Can I win more than one medal? Answer YES! The program starts the week of July 6<sup>th</sup> and a participant can win one medal per week by completing one of the 4 ways to win by each Friday. (the week medal opportunity ends 7/10, 7/17, 7/24 and 7/31) You could win up to 4 medals!
