## **Richard Willborn**

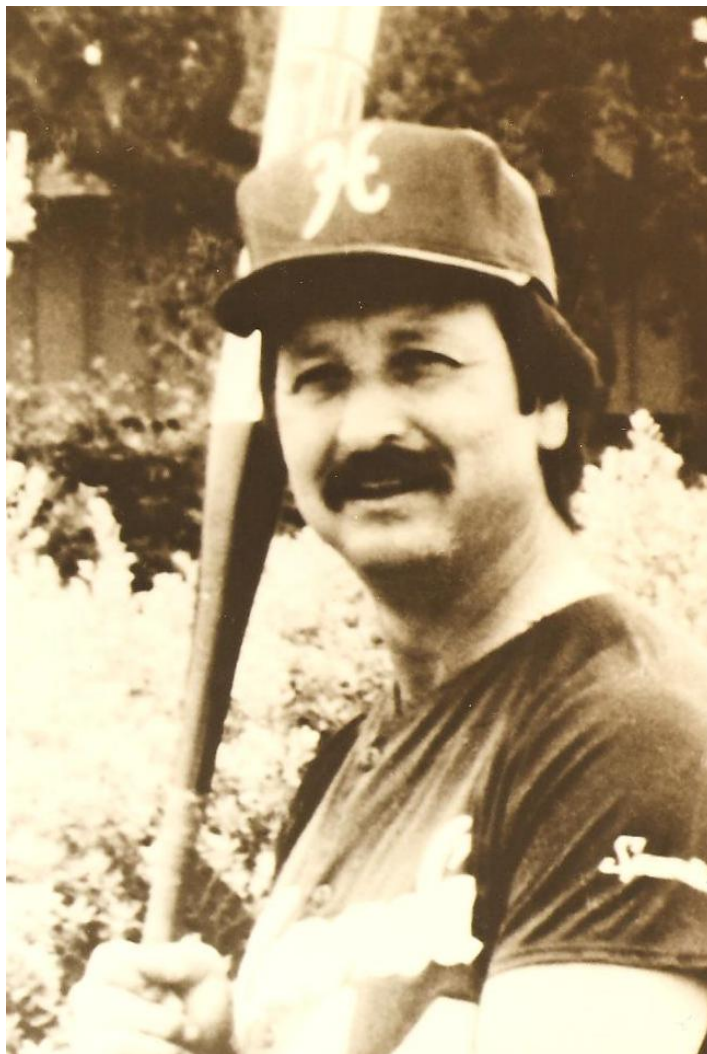

- 1968 Selected to the All District and All State Baseball Teams while playing for Central Catholic High School, San Antonio.
- 1968 Selected to the Honorable Mention All State Football and Track & Field Teams.
- Participated in nine (9) T.A.A.F. State Tournaments.
- Team won two (2) T.A.A.F. State Championship and was Runner up twice.
- Selected to eight (8) T.A.A.F. All Tournament Teams while participating with seven different softball teams:
  - KCOR in 1973;
  - Anchor Lounge in 1974;
  - Ray Carpenter Construction in 1975 and 1976;
  - C.C. Brick & Lumber 1978;
  - Pearl Brewery in 1979;
  - The Texans (Euleless) 1982;
  - Stone City Stars in 1983.
- Named the T.A.A.F. State Championships Most Valuable Player once.
- Participated in nine (9) ASA National Championship Tournaments.
- Team won four (4) ASA National Championships.

- Selected to three (3) USSSA All World Teams.
- Selected to eight (8) International Association of Fire Fighters All American Teams.
- In mid 1970's to mid 1980's, Richard was part of the "Texas Connection" (Buddy Slater, Dick Bartel, Bill Ferguson, Mickey McCarty and Richard) that led Nelson's Paint, Campbell's Carpet and Howard's Western Steer to the Triple Crown (ASA, USSSA & NSA) of softball.
