

Umpire-In-Chief

Responsibilities

The Umpire-In-Chief is a contracted position that oversees the conduct of every league/tournament game and ensures that all games comply with all rules and regulations. The Umpire-In-Chief is also responsible for the recruiting, training, and scheduling of league umpires.

UIC Experiences:

- Must be USA formally ASA Softball Umpire Certified
- Must have Adult Softball umpiring experiences.

Responsibilities Include:

- Actively recruit and train umpire staff for three (3) the adult softball league seasons.
- Coordinate annual official training class to maintain Texas Amateur Athletic Federation Certification.
- Ensure that all umpire candidates stay in compliance with Texas Amateur Athletic Federation's (T.A.A.F.) rules and policies.
- Regularly meet with Recreation Staff to evaluate and recommend program improvements.
- Supervise umpire staff for three (3) seasons of softball per year.
- Schedule umpires for all league, playoff, and tournament games at the Hurst Athletic Complex.
- Reports any maintenance issues of the Athletic Complex to the Recreation Manager.
- As a liaison between the program participants and the City of Hurst Recreation Division.
- Being on site during league, playoffs, and tournaments at the Hurst Athletic Complex or appointing a qualified City of Hurst Umpire during their absence.
