Parking: Buses & Athletes: Attached is the route all buses should take to drop off their athletes and the designated bus parking area. Athletes and parents will park in north parking lot only entrance will be on Bicentennial.

Uniform: Relay team members will be required to wear shirts that are alike in color but not necessarily alike in style.

Proof of Age: A TAAF # will be required by all athletes in order to compete at the Region 2 Track & Field Meet. You will need to show proof of age with a copy of your birth certificate, driver's license, passport, baptismal certificate or Military Department ID card prior to the start of the regional meet.

Club Membership: All participants will be identified by the nearest T.A.A.F. member city or affiliate membership. The affiliate membership fee is \$100.00. Deadline for registration in State Office by June 30, 2018.

Meet Entries: All meet entries must be done online to THE STATE TAAF OFFICE by June 30, 2023 by 11:59 p.m. The DEADLINE will not be extended once the TAAF office closes, so please see that all of your entries are entered on time so that we may prepare a successful meet for all athletes. Athletes should only be entered in one (1) one division. A race number will be assigned to each athlete. It must be worn in front of the athlete's uniform. If race number is lost, athlete must purchase another number for \$10.00. Coaches please take care of athlete's race numbers during the two (2) day meet to avoid any extra charges.

Qualification: The top three (3) athletes and the top three (3) relay teams in the divisions. All divisions will qualify to the State Track and Field Meet in Brownsville, Texas on July 27-30, 2023. (Please note that if our Region 2 has 2,000 TAAF participants registered before June 30, 2023, then we may take the top six (6) instead of the top one (1), two (2), or three (3). Please note that there will be no alternates advancing to the state meet, but only the qualifiers. Only the top three (3), four (4), five (5), or six (6) will qualify.

State Entry Fees: All participants must pay \$10.00 per event in which they qualify for the state meet. This fee must be paid at the Region 2 Track and Field Meet. Payments will be taken at the City Of Mcallen 1000 S Ware Rd, McAllen, TX 78501. Or onsite at Mcallen Veterans Memorial Stadium locker room.

Medal & Ribbon

Pick Up Top three (3) athletes will receive medals and 4th-8th place will receive ribbons per event. Once results are finalized and posted athletes may pick up their medal/ribbon at the Southwest locker room at PSJA Stadium

Competition: Contestant ages 6 and Under may only enter two (2) events which are the 50M and 100M. The schedule of events will be posted at the track & field meet. Contestants ages 12 and under may enter only three (3) events (they may all be running events).

Contestants between the ages of 13-18 may enter five (5) events. Only three (3) may be running. **Note:** Alternates on relays count as an event-This is only if the athlete actually competes in the event. If the athlete does not run an event, then it does not count towards a running event. No contestant shall enter more than two (2) of the following events: 400 meter dash, 800 meter dash, 1600 meter run, or 3200 meter run. This does not prevent a 400, 800, 1600, or 3200-meter contestant from running in relays, provided he or she is entered in no more than three (3) total running events.

Spikes: Only UIL regulated (1/4") spikes are permitted on the McAllen Veterans Memorial Stadium track.

Implements: Field Event Implements weigh-ins will be from 7:00 a.m. -7:45 a.m. inside the ticket booth located on the south side of the stadium.

Pole Vault: Regulation poles must be used. All pole vaulters must weigh in prior to the beginning of the event and present their pole vault pole for certification. For safety purposes, we are encouraging pole vaulters to wear safety helmets if necessary.
